## **Consumer Fireworks**

Specifically Permitted

Roman candles, skyrockets, helicopter rockets, cylindrical and cone fountains, wheels, torches, dipped sticks, mines and shells, firecrackers

with soft casings, and novelties (size limitations specified).

Specifically Prohibited

All fireworks that are not defined as salable consumer fireworks.

**Selling Period** The sale or use of fireworks may be suspended in any area where the

Dept. of Natural Resources has declared the wild fire danger to be

high/extreme or depleted of resources.

**Age of Purchase** 18 years if age or older.

**Licensing** Annual wholesale and retail licenses required. Apply to the State Fire

Marshal.

Wholesale license \$50 Retail license \$10 every

two (2) years.
