



ALABAMA Consumer Fireworks

Specifically permitted	Class C consumer fireworks per the United States Department of Transportation, including, but not limited to, aerial devices, audible ground devices, sparkling devices, and novelties and those items that comply with the construction, chemical composition, and labeling regulations promulgated by the United States Consumer Product Safety Commission and permitted for use by the general public under their regulations.
Specifically prohibited	Manufacture, possession, sale or use of “illegal ground salutes,” fireworks containing more than 2 grains of explosive composition; any mail-order fireworks.
Selling period	June 20 through July 10 and December 15 through January 2 Sales from tents or motor vehicles are prohibited.
Age of purchase	16 years of age or older.
Licensing	The State Fire Marshal shall charge for permits issued as follows: (1) Manufacturer, three thousand dollars (\$3,000). (2) Distributor, three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00). (3) Wholesaler, one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00). (4) Retailer, three hundred dollars (\$300.00) and varies by type of fireworks sold. (5) Seasonal Retailer, three hundred dollars (\$300.00) and varies by type of fireworks sold. (6) Seasonal Retailer after July 10, one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) and varies by type of fireworks sold. (7) Display, seventy five dollars (\$75.00). (8) Display, one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) if filed less than 10 business days before display date. NOTE: Additional permit fees required for manufacturing. Effective July 12, 2021
