### Consumer Fireworks

<b>Specifically Permitted</b>	Devices approved and listed by State Fire Marshal which emit a shower of sparks upon burning, do not contain any explosive compounds, do not detonate or explode, are handheld or ground based, cannot propel themselves through the air, and contain no more than 100 grams of the chemical compound that produces sparks upon burning. Any device that is not included in the list of approved items is prohibited, except that snakes, smoke devices, trick noisemakers, party poppers, booby traps, snappers, trick match. cigarette load, and auto burglar alarms, each of which are subject to size limitations and may be sold at all times.
<b>Specifically Prohibited</b>	Firecrackers, torpedoes, skyrockets, roman candles, daygo bombs, and any fireworks containing explosive or flammable compounds.
<b>Selling Period</b>	Seasonal Retailers: June 20 - July 5 and December 10- January 2. Certain fireworks are permitted to be "used" on the following designated holidays:  (a) New Year's Day, January 1; (b) Independence Day, July 4; or (c) New Year's Eve, December 31. Check with local authorities having jurisdiction for further rules or restrictions on "sales" and "use."
<b>Age of Purchase</b>	18 years or older.
