Consumer Fireworks

Specifically permitted	Items that comply with regulations of CPSC and DOT definitions. Permit required for each 5,000 individual units of firecrackers.
Specifically prohibited	Aerial fireworks such as, bottle rockets, sky rockets, missile-type rockets, helicopters, torpedoes, daygo bombs, roman candles, flying pigs, and jumping jacks, which move about the ground farther than inside a circle with a radius of twelve feet as measured from the point where the item was placed and ignited, aerial shells and mines.
Selling Period	5 Days prior to use. Dec 26 to midnight Dec 31 and June 29 to July 4. Permitted use: From 9:00 p.m. on New Year's Eve to 1:00 a.m. on New Year's Day; From 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Chinese New Year's Day; and From 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on the Fourth of July; or) From 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. as allowed by permit pursuant to section 132D-10 if the proposed cultural use is to occur at any time other than during the permissible periods. Check with each local authority having jurisdiction for any further restrictions.
Age of Purchase	18 years or older.
Licensing	Annual licenses required and expire March 31. \$3,000 for importers, \$2,000 for wholesaler's, \$1,000 for storage, and \$500 for each retailer's site for each year or fraction of a year in which the licensee plans to conduct business and shall be payable to the County of Hawaii.
