

## **NEW MEXICO**

## **Consumer Fireworks**

Specifically Permitted

All items that comply with the requirements of the CPSC, except stick-type rockets having a tube less than 1/4" inside diameter. Municipalities may prohibit use of aerial and ground audible devices.

Specifically Prohibited

**Selling Period** Permissible fireworks may be sold at retail:

Between June 20 and July 6

Six days preceding and including New Year's Day Three days preceding and including Chinese New Year

September 16 and May 5 Cinco de Mayo

Except permissible fireworks may be sold all year in permanent retail

stores whose primary business is tourism.

**Age of Purchase** 16 years of age and older.

**Licensing** Manufacturer license \$1,500

Distributor license 2,000 Wholesaler license 1,000

Display distributor license 1,000 Specialty retailer license 750;

Retailer permit 100; or replacement permit 20.

**Authority** New Mexico State Fire Marshal

**Law Number** Article 2C, Section 60-2C-1 through 11

**Statute(s)** Article 2C Fireworks Licensing and Safety
