### Consumer Fireworks

<b>Specifically Permitted</b>	Ground-based or hand held sparkling devices including cylindrical fountains, cone fountains, and wood sparklers/dipped sticks; party poppers, snappers.
<b>Specifically Prohibited</b>	Aerial consumer fireworks, firecrackers and chasers, skyrockets, roman candles, bombs, and metal wire sparklers.
<b>Selling Period</b>	Sales of Sparkling Devices by certified permanent and specialty retailers can only occur from June 1 to July 5 and December 26 to January 1.  Sales of Sparkling Devices by certified temporary stands or tents can only occur from June 20 to July 5 and December 26 to January 1.
<b>Age of Purchase</b>	18 years of age and older
<b>Licensing</b>	A manufacturer, distributor, or wholesaler - \$5,000 Annually A specialty retailer - \$2,500 Annually A permanent retailer - \$200 Annually A temporary seasonal retailer - \$250 per season
