



OKLAHOMA Consumer Fireworks

Specifically Permitted

All consumer fireworks that meet the requirements of the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) are permitted, including 500-gram cakes, firecrackers, sparklers, and bottle rockets.

Specifically Prohibited

Items such as M-80s, mail-order sales, and door-to-door sales are strictly prohibited.

Selling Period

Year Round by licensed retailers, wholesalers, distributors, and manufacturers.

Private Property Usage Rules

Burn Bans: Fireworks cannot be discharged on private property if a county burn ban is in effect or if fire weather conditions (sustained winds over 20 mph, low humidity, or critically dry fuel) are met.

Fire Department Notification: You must notify your local fire department prior to setting off fireworks on private property.

Age of Purchase

12 years of age and older

Licensing

May also conduct retail sales), Exhibitors, Exhibitor
